4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.457 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.457. LIABILITY OF MANUFACTURER OF MODIFIED
8	AUTOMATED MOTOR VEHICLE. (a) The manufacturer of an automated
9	motor vehicle is not liable for damage that arises from an accident
10	involving the vehicle if a person other than the manufacturer
11	modified or attempted to modify the vehicle without the
12	manufacturer's consent and:
13	(1) the modification or attempted modification of the
14	vehicle was the direct cause of the accident; or
15	(2) the modification or attempted modification of the
16	vehicle interfered with the normal operation of the vehicle.
17	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply if the damage that arises
18	from an accident involving an automated motor vehicle is caused by a
19	defect that was present at the time of the vehicle's manufacture or
20	first sale.
21	SECTION 2. Section 550.064(b), Transportation Code, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	(b) An accident report form prepared by the department must:
24	(1) require sufficiently detailed information to

No. 119 disclose the cause and conditions of and the persons and vehicles 1 involved in an accident if the form is for the report to be made by a 2 3 person investigating the accident; 4 (2) include a way to designate and identify a peace 5 officer, firefighter, or emergency medical services employee who is involved in an accident while driving a law enforcement vehicle, 6 fire department vehicle, or emergency medical services vehicle 7 8 while performing the person's duties; 9 (3) require a statement by a person described by Subdivision (2) as to the nature of the accident; [and] 10 include a way to designate whether an individual 11 (4) 12 involved in an accident wants to be contacted by a person seeking to obtain employment as a professional described by Section 38.01(12), 13 14 Penal Code; 15 (5) include a way to indicate whether: 16 (A) an automated motor vehicle as defined by 17 Section 545.451 was at fault or otherwise involved in the accident; 18 and 19 (B) the owner of an automated motor vehicle involved in the accident was contacted; and 20 21 (6) include a way to indicate whether an oversize or overweight vehicle described by Subtitle E was at fault or 22 23 otherwise involved in the accident. 24 SECTION 3. Section 545.457, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or 25 after the effective date of this Act. 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 27
