- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.1101, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.1101. NOTIFICATION OF CHARTER APPLICATION OR
- 8 ESTABLISHMENT OF CAMPUS; OPEN DATE. (a) The commissioner by rule
- 9 shall adopt a procedure for providing notice to the following
- 10 persons on receipt by the commissioner of an application for a
- 11 charter for an open-enrollment charter school under Section 12.110,
- 12 [or of] notice of the establishment of a campus as authorized under
- 13 Section 12.101(b-4), or a request for approval of an expansion
- 14 amendment to establish a new campus submitted under Section 12.114:
- 15 (1) the board of trustees of each school district from
- 16 which the proposed open-enrollment charter school or campus is
- 17 likely to draw students, as determined by the commissioner; and
- 18 (2) each member of the legislature that represents the
- 19 geographic area to be served by the proposed school or campus, as
- 20 determined by the commissioner.
- 21 (b) The procedure adopted under Subsection (a) must require
- 22 the notice to:
- 23 (1) be provided not later than 18 months before the
- 24 date on which the open-enrollment charter school or campus is

- 1 <u>anticipated to open; and</u>
- 2 (2) include sufficient specificity regarding the
- 3 proposed location of the school or campus for each school district
- 4 described by Subsection (a)(1) to adequately anticipate any
- 5 resulting changes in enrollment at each district campus.
- 6 (c) A proposed open-enrollment charter school or campus for
- 7 which notice is provided under Subsection (a) may not open:
- 8 <u>(1) before the anticipated opening date provided in</u>
- 9 the notice; or
- 10 (2) before June 1 or later than October 15 of any year.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 12.1101, Education Code, as amended by
- 12 this Act, applies beginning with a new open-enrollment charter
- 13 school or campus that is anticipated to open for the 2021-2022
- 14 school year.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
