The change in law made by this Act applies only 21 to a driver's license suspension based on conduct that occurred on or after the effective date of this Act. A driver's license 22 suspension based on conduct that occurred before the effective date 23 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct 24

1 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that 2 purpose. For purposes of this Act, conduct occurred before the 3 effective date of this Act if any element of the conduct occurred 4 before that date.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
