16	Subsection (c-2); and
17	(2) successfully completing all curriculum
18	requirements for that endorsement adopted by the State Board of
19	Education:
20	(A) without modification of the curriculum; or
21	(B) with modification of the curriculum,
22	provided that the curriculum, as modified, is sufficiently rigorous
23	as determined by the student's admission, review, and dismissal

1 (c-8) For purposes of Subsection (c-7), the admission,
2 review, and dismissal committee of a student in a special education
3 program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, shall determine whether the
4 student is required to achieve satisfactory performance on an
5 end-of-course assessment instrument to earn an endorsement on the
6 student's transcript.

7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-20208 school year.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
