4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.0833 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.0833. ACCESS TO UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE
8	SPONSORED ACTIVITIES FOR STUDENTS UNDER SUPERVISION OF TEXAS
9	JUVENILE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT. (a) The University Interscholastic
10	League may provide students receiving educational services under
11	the supervision of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department with the
12	opportunity to participate in activities sponsored by the league in
13	the same manner that the league provides the opportunity to
14	participate to students enrolled in public schools. Participation
15	of a public school in an activity in which students receiving
16	educational services under the supervision of the department
17	participate is optional.
18	(b) Before providing students described by Subsection (a)
19	with the opportunity to participate in activities described by that
20	subsection, the University Interscholastic League must:
21	(1) enter into a memorandum of understanding with the
22	Texas Juvenile Justice Department regarding the policies
23	governing:
24	(A) the conditions of eligibility for students

1	under the supervision of the department in activities sponsored by
2	the league, including the:
3	(i) ages of students eligible to
4	participate;
5	(ii) academic performance requirements for
6	students; and
7	(iii) standards of behavior for students;
8	(B) the appropriate league in which students
9	under the supervision of the department will participate; and
10	(C) the duties of the department regarding other
11	policies of the league, including fees, insurance, and
12	transportation; and
13	(2) adopt rules and administrative guidelines to
14	implement this section, including procedures allowing for the
15	optional participation of public schools in the activities provided
16	to students under the supervision of the department under this
17	section.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20	provided by Section 39 Article III Texas Constitution If this

20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
