1 AN ACT 2 relating to permissible uses of the instructional materials 3 allotment. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 31.0211(c), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 7 Subject to Subsection (d), funds allotted under this (c) section may be used to: 8 9 (1) purchase: (A) materials on the list adopted by 10 the 11 commissioner, as provided by Section 31.0231; 12 (B) instructional materials, regardless of 13 whether the instructional materials are on the list adopted under 14 Section 31.024; (C) 15 consumable instructional materials, including workbooks; 16 17 (D) instructional materials for use in bilingual education classes, as provided by Section 31.029; 18 19 (E) instructional materials for use in college preparatory courses under Section 28.014, as provided by Section 20 21 31.031; 22 (F) supplemental instructional materials, as 23 provided by Section 31.035; 24 (G) state-developed open education resource

No. 199 instructional materials, as provided by Subchapter B-1; 1 2 (H) instructional materials and technological 3 equipment under any continuing contracts of the district in effect on September 1, 2011; and 4 5 (I) technological equipment necessary to support the use of materials included on the list adopted by the 6 7 commissioner under Section 31.0231 or any instructional materials 8 purchased with an allotment under this section; and (2) pay: 9 (A) for training educational personnel directly 10 11 involved in student learning in the appropriate of use 12 instructional materials, and for providing for access to technological equipment for instructional use; and 13 14 (B) the salary and other expenses of an employee 15 who<u>:</u> (i) provides technical support for the use 16 17 of technological equipment directly involved in student learning; 18 or (ii) is directly involved in: 19 (a) student learning; or 20 21 (b) addressing the social and 22 emotional health of students. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 23 24 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 25 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 27
