## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the inclusion of instruction about mental health in the
3	required curriculum for public school students.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002(a), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) Each school district that offers kindergarten through
8	grade 12 shall offer, as a required curriculum:
9	(1) a foundation curriculum that includes:
10	(A) English language arts;
11	(B) mathematics;
12	(C) science; and
13	(D) social studies, consisting of Texas, United
14	States, and world history, government, economics, with emphasis on
15	the free enterprise system and its benefits, and geography; and
16	(2) an enrichment curriculum that includes:
17	(A) to the extent possible, languages other than
18	English;
19	(B) health, <u>including mental health</u> , with
20	emphasis on the importance of $\underline{\cdot}$
21	(i) proper nutrition and exercise; and
22	(ii) the relationship between physical and
23	<pre>mental health;</pre>
24	(C) physical education;

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1 (D) fine arts; 2 career and technology education; (E) 3 technology applications; 4 (G) religious literature, including the Hebrew Scriptures (Old Testament) and New Testament, and its impact on 5 6 history and literature; and 7 (H) personal financial literacy. 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year. 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13

Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
