A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the temporary confidentiality and automatic expunction
- 3 of records and files relating to certain nonviolent misdemeanor
- 4 offenses.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 55, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended by adding Article 55.07 to read as follows:
- 8 Art. 55.07. TEMPORARY CONFIDENTIALITY AND AUTOMATIC
- 9 EXPUNCTION OF CERTAIN RECORDS AND FILES. (a) This article applies
- 10 to a case in which the most serious offense that the defendant was
- 11 convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication community
- 12 supervision for was a nonviolent Class B or Class C misdemeanor.
- 13 (b) The trial court presiding over a case that the court
- 14 determines is subject to this article shall order that all records
- 15 and files relating to the arrest and prosecution be kept
- 16 confidential and not be disclosed to the public.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> Records and files made confidential under this article
- 18 remain confidential until the expunction of those records and files
- 19 under Subsection (d) unless the defendant is arrested for or
- 20 charged with a violent offense before the expunction occurs. A
- 21 defendant who is arrested or charged as described by this
- 22 subsection is ineligible for automatic expunction under Subsection
- 23 (d) with respect to records and files in any Class B or Class C
- 24 misdemeanor case otherwise subject to this article.

- 1 (d) Records and files made confidential under this article
- 2 other than records and files for a defendant described by
- 3 Subsection (c) shall be automatically expunged by the trial court
- 4 not later than the 30th day after:
- 5 (1) the first anniversary of the date the defendant's
- 6 sentence was discharged or the defendant received a discharge and
- 7 dismissal under Chapter 42A, if the most serious offense that the
- 8 defendant was convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication
- 9 community supervision for was a Class C misdemeanor; or
- 10 (2) the second anniversary of the date the defendant's
- 11 sentence was discharged or the defendant received a discharge and
- 12 dismissal under Chapter 42A, if the most serious offense that the
- 13 defendant was convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication
- 14 community supervision for was a Class B misdemeanor.
- 15 SECTION 2. Article 55.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 16 added by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense
- 21 was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element
- 22 of the offense occurred before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
