A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to a strategic plan to address postpartum depression. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Health and Safety 4 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 32.046 to read as follows: Sec. 32.046. POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION STRATEGIC PLAN. 6 (a) The commission shall develop and implement a five-year strategic 7 plan to improve access to postpartum depression screening, 8 referral, treatment, and support services. Not later than 9 September 1 of the last fiscal year in each five-year period, the 10 commission shall develop a new strategic plan for the next five 11 fiscal years beginning with the following fiscal year. 12 (b) The strategic plan must provide strategies to: 13 14 (1) increase awareness among state-administered program providers who may serve women who are at risk of or are 15 16 experiencing postpartum depression about the prevalence and effects of postpartum depression on outcomes for women and 17 18 children; (2) establish a referral network of community-based 19 mental health providers and support services addressing postpartum 20 depression; 21 (3) increase women's access to formal and informal 22 23 peer support services, including access to certified peer specialists who have received additional training related to 24

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1 postpartum depression;

2 (4) raise public awareness of and reduce the stigma
3 related to postpartum depression; and

4 (5) leverage sources of funding to support existing
5 community-based postpartum depression screening, referral,
6 treatment, and support services.

7 <u>(c) The commission shall coordinate with the department,</u> 8 <u>the statewide health coordinating council, the office of mental</u> 9 <u>health coordination, and the statewide behavioral health</u> 10 <u>coordinating council in developing the strategic plan.</u>

11 (d) The commission, in consultation with the department, 12 the statewide health coordinating council, the office of mental 13 health coordination, and the statewide behavioral health 14 coordinating council, shall annually review and update, as 15 necessary, the strategic plan.

16 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2020, the Health and 17 Human Services Commission shall develop the initial strategic plan 18 required by Section 32.046, Health and Safety Code, as added by this 19 Act.

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
