## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a strategic plan to address postpartum depression.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 32.046 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 32.046. POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION STRATEGIC PLAN. (a)
7	The executive commissioner shall develop and the department shall
8	implement a five-year strategic plan to improve access to
9	postpartum depression screening, referral, treatment, and support
10	services. Not later than September 1 of the last fiscal year in
11	each five-year period, the executive commissioner shall develop a
12	new strategic plan for the next five fiscal years beginning with the
13	following fiscal year.
14	(b) The strategic plan must provide strategies to:
15	(1) increase awareness among state-administered
16	program providers who may serve women who are at risk of or are
17	experiencing postpartum depression about the prevalence and
18	effects of postpartum depression on outcomes for women and
19	<pre>children;</pre>
20	(2) establish a referral network of community-based
21	mental health providers and support services addressing postpartum
22	depression;
23	(3) increase women's access to formal and informal
24	neer support services including access to certified neer

- 1 specialists who have received additional training related to
- 2 postpartum depression;
- 3 (4) raise public awareness of and reduce the stigma
- 4 related to postpartum depression; and
- 5 (5) leverage sources of funding to support existing
- 6 community-based postpartum depression screening, referral,
- 7 treatment, and support services.
- 8 (c) The executive commissioner shall coordinate with the
- 9 statewide health coordinating council, the office of mental health
- 10 coordination, and the statewide behavioral health coordinating
- 11 council in developing the strategic plan.
- 12 (d) The executive commissioner, in consultation with the
- 13 statewide health coordinating council, the office of mental health
- 14 coordination, and the statewide behavioral health coordinating
- 15 council, shall annually review and update, as necessary, the
- 16 strategic plan.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2020, the executive
- 18 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 19 develop the initial strategic plan required by Section 32.046,
- 20 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
