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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to a policy requiring public and private primary and 3 secondary schools and public junior colleges to provide local law 4 enforcement agencies certain information regarding certain 5 individuals authorized to carry a handgun on a campus.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 37.0811(g), Education Code, is amended 8 to read as follows:

9 (g) The identity of a school marshal appointed under this 10 section is confidential, except as provided by Section <u>37.0814 of</u> 11 <u>this code or Section</u> 1701.260(j), Occupations Code, and is not 12 subject to a request under Chapter 552, Government Code.

13 SECTION 2. Section 37.0813(g), Education Code, is amended 14 to read as follows:

(g) The identity of a school marshal appointed under this section is confidential, except as provided by Section <u>37.0814 of</u> <u>this code or Section</u> 1701.260(j), Occupations Code, and is not subject to a request under Chapter 552, Government Code.

SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 37, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 37.0814 to read as follows:

21Sec. 37.0814. LAWENFORCEMENTCOMMUNICATIONAND22COORDINATION POLICY. (a)This section applies to a school23district, open-enrollment charter school, or private school that:24(1)appoints a school marshal under Section 37.0811 or

2	(2) authorizes any other individual to carry a handgun
3	for security purposes under written regulations or written
4	authorization of the district or school.
5	(b) The board of trustees of a school district or the
6	governing body of an open-enrollment charter school or private
7	school that is subject to this section shall adopt a policy
8	regarding communication and coordination with local law
9	enforcement agencies.
10	(c) A policy adopted under this section must require the
11	school district, open-enrollment charter school, or private school
12	<u>to:</u>
13	(1) provide each law enforcement agency that has
14	jurisdiction over the district or school with:
15	(A) a list of each campus at which an individual
16	described by Subsection (a) is authorized to carry a handgun; and
17	(B) the identity of each individual described by
18	Subsection (a) and the campus where that individual is regularly
19	employed; and
20	(2) update, as necessary, the information provided
21	under Subdivision (1).
22	(d) Information provided to a law enforcement agency under a
23	policy adopted under this section regarding the identity or place
24	of employment of an individual described by Subsection (a) is
25	confidential, may be used by the law enforcement agency only for law
26	enforcement purposes, and is not subject to a request under Chapter

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1 SECTION 4. Section 51.220(h), Education Code, is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 (h) The identity of a school marshal appointed under this 4 section is confidential, except as provided by Section <u>51.221 of</u> 5 <u>this code or Section</u> 1701.260(j), Occupations Code, and is not 6 subject to a request under Chapter 552, Government Code.

SECTION 5. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
amended by adding Section 51.221 to read as follows:

9 <u>Sec. 51.221. LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNICATION AND</u> 10 <u>COORDINATION POLICY. (a) This section applies to a public junior</u> 11 <u>college, as defined by Section 61.003, that appoints a school</u> 12 <u>marshal under Section 51.220.</u>

13 <u>(b) The governing board of a public junior college that is</u> 14 <u>subject to this section shall adopt a policy regarding</u> 15 <u>communication and coordination with local law enforcement</u> 16 <u>agencies.</u>

17 (c) A policy adopted under this section must require the 18 public junior college to:

19 (1) provide each law enforcement agency that has
20 jurisdiction over the public junior college with:

21 (A) a list of each campus at which a school 22 marshal is authorized to carry a handgun; and 23 (B) the identity of each school marshal and the

24 campus where that individual is regularly employed; and

25 (2) update, as necessary, the information provided 26 under Subdivision (1).

27 (d) Information provided to a law enforcement agency under a

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2 of employment of a school marshal is confidential, may be used by

3 the law enforcement agency only for law enforcement purposes, and

- 4 is not subject to a request under Chapter 552, Government Code.
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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
