4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,

6 is amended by adding Section 201.2075 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 201.2075. CROSS-BORDER TRAFFIC CONGESTION WEB PORTAL.

8 (a) The department in collaboration with the Texas A&M

9 Transportation Institute shall develop and maintain a publicly

10 <u>accessible web portal designed to provide real-time information</u>

11 regarding motor vehicle movements at ports of entry between this

12 state and the United Mexican States and in surrounding areas for the

13 purpose of alleviating cross-border motor vehicle traffic

14 congestion.

15 (b) In developing and maintaining the web portal, the

16 department may collaborate with other governmental entities,

17 including federal agencies, state and local transportation

18 agencies of this state or the United Mexican States, and political

19 <u>subdivisions of this state or the United Mexican States.</u>

SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2021, the Texas

21 Department of Transportation shall develop the web portal required

22 under Section 201.2075, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
