- 18 (2) statewide crime statistics for the crimes reported
- 19 <u>under Subdivision (1).</u>
- 20 (b) In compiling the information for the report, the
- 21 department shall use information available in the National
- 22 <u>Incident-Based Reporting System of the Uniform Crime Reporting</u>
- 23 Program of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Texas
- 24 Incident-Based Reporting System of the department.
