A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the requirement that a political subdivision with authority to impose a tax post certain information on an Internet website.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2051, Government Code, is amended by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER E. INTERNET WEBSITE

Sec. 2051.151. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter applies only to a political subdivision with the authority to impose a tax that at any time on or after January 1, 2019, maintained a publicly accessible Internet website.

Sec. 2051.152. INFORMATION REQUIRED ON WEBSITE. A political subdivision to which this section applies shall post on a publicly accessible Internet website the following information:

(1) the political subdivision's contact information, including a mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address;

(2) each elected officer of the political subdivision;

(3) each candidate for an elected office of the political subdivision;

(4) the date and location of the next election for officers of the political subdivision;

(5) the requirements and deadline for filing for candidacy of each elected office of the political subdivision,

1 which shall be continuously posted for at least one year before the  
2 election day for the office;

3 (6) each notice of a meeting under Subchapter C,  
4 Chapter 551; and

5 (7) each record of a meeting under Subchapter B,  
6 Chapter 551.

7 SECTION 2. Sections 2051.152(6) and (7), Government Code,  
8 as added by this Act, apply only to a meeting held on or after the  
9 effective date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
