H.B. No. 314

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to use of compensatory education allotment funding to
3 provide assistance to students at risk of dropping out of school who
4 are pregnant or who are parents and to reporting through the Public
5 Education Information Management System.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by
8 adding Subsections (c-3) and (c-4) to read as follows:

9 (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), funds allocated under
10 this section may be used to:

11 (1) provide child-care services or assistance with
12 child-care expenses for students at risk of dropping out of school,
13 as described by Section 29.081(d)(5); or

14 (2) pay the costs associated with services provided
15 through a life skills program in accordance with Sections
16 29.085(b)(1) and (3)-(7).

17 (c-4) Not later than January 1, 2020, the commissioner shall
18 adopt rules requiring the Public Education Information Management
19 System (PEIMS) to include pregnancy as a reason a student withdraws
20 from or otherwise no longer attends public school.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
