- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsections (c-3) and (c-4) to read as follows:
- 9 (c-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), funds allocated under
- 10 this section may be used to:
- 11 (1) provide child-care services or assistance with
- 12 child-care expenses for students at risk of dropping out of school,
- as described by Section 29.081(d)(5); or
- 14 (2) pay the costs associated with services provided
- 15 through a life skills program in accordance with Sections
- 16 29.085(b)(1) and (3)-(7).
- 17 <u>(c-4)</u> Not later than January 1, 2020, the commissioner shall
- 18 adopt rules requiring the Public Education Information Management
- 19 System (PEIMS) to include pregnancy as a reason a student withdraws
- 20 from or otherwise no longer attends public school.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
