BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 521.1811, Transportation Code, is 6 transferred to Subchapter R, Chapter 521, Transportation Code, 7 renumbered as Section 521.4261, Transportation Code, and amended to 8 read as follows:

9 Sec. <u>521.4261</u> [521.1811]. WAIVER OF FEES FOR FOSTER CARE 10 YOUTH. A person is exempt from the payment of any fee for the 11 issuance of a driver's license <u>or personal identification</u> 12 <u>certificate</u>, as provided under this chapter, if that person is:

(1) younger than 18 years of age and in the managing conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services; or

16 (2) at least 18 years of age, but younger than 21 years
17 of age, and resides in a foster care placement, the cost of which is
18 paid by the Department of Family and Protective Services.
