5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 31, Parks and Wildlife
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 31.1071 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 31.1071. OPERATION OF MOTORBOAT WITH EMERGENCY ENGINE
8	CUTOFF SWITCH. (a) In this section, "engine cutoff switch" means
9	an emergency switch installed on a motorboat that:
10	(1) is designed to shut off the engine if:
11	(A) the motorboat operator using a lanyard
12	attachment activates the switch by falling overboard or otherwise
13	moving beyond the length of the lanyard; or
14	(B) the motorboat operator or a passenger using a
15	wireless attachment activates the switch by falling overboard and
16	submerging a man-overboard transmitter; and
17	(2) attaches:
18	(A) physically to the motorboat operator through
19	the use of a lanyard worn by the operator; or
20	(B) wirelessly through the use of a
21	water-activated man-overboard transmitter worn by the motorboat
22	operator or any similarly equipped passenger on the motorboat.
23	(b) A motorboat operator may not operate a motorboat less
24	than 26 feet in length and equipped by the manufacturer with an

1	engine cutoff switch while the motorboat is under way and moving at
2	greater than headway speed without first verifying that the switch
3	is operational and fully functional and properly attaching the
4	lanyard or wireless attachment, as appropriate for the specific
5	motorboat, to the operator's body or to the clothing or personal
6	flotation device being worn by the operator.
7	SECTION 2. Section 31.127, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
8	amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
9	(g) A person who operates a motorboat in violation of
10	Section 31.1071 commits an offense punishable by a fine of not more
11	than \$200.
12	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
