1-17 relating to eligibility for the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial  
 1-18 Monument.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, is amended  
 1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 (a) A person is eligible to have the person's name on the  
 1-23 monument if the person was killed in the line of duty and was:

1-24 (1) a law enforcement officer or peace officer for  
 1-25 this state or a political subdivision of this state under Article  
 1-26 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;

1-27 (2) a federal law enforcement officer or special agent  
 1-28 performing duties in this state, including those officers under  
 1-29 Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure; ~~or~~

1-30 (3) a corrections or detention officer or county or  
 1-31 municipal jailer employed or appointed by a municipal, county, or  
 1-32 state penal institution in this state; or

1-33 (4) employed by this state or a political subdivision  
 1-34 of this state and considered by the person's employer to be a  
 1-35 trainee for a position described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).

1-36 SECTION 2. (a) Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as  
 1-37 amended by this Act, applies to the eligibility of a person who was  
 1-38 killed in the line of duty before, on, or after the effective date  
 1-39 of this Act.

1-40 (b) The Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall  
 1-41 reconsider a nomination to have a person's name added to the Texas  
 1-42 Peace Officers' Memorial Monument under Section 3105.0035,  
 1-43 Government Code, if the person was determined to be ineligible  
 1-44 before the effective date of this Act and the person may be eligible  
 1-45 under Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as amended by this Act.

1-46 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
