## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 1-18 relating to eligibility for the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial Monument 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-21

1-22 1-23 (a) A person is eligible to have the person's name on the monument if the person was killed in the line of duty and was:

1-24 (1) a law enforcement officer or peace officer for 1-25 this state or a political subdivision of this state under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or other law; 1-26

1-27 1-28 (2) a federal law enforcement officer or special agent performing duties in this state, including those officers under Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure; [or] 1-29

1-30 (3) a corrections or detention officer or county or 1-31 municipal jailer employed or appointed by a municipal, county, or 1-32 state penal institution in this state; or

1-33 (4) employed by this state or a political subdivision of this state and considered by the person's employer to be a trainee for a position described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3). SECTION 2. (a) Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as 1-34 1-35

1-36 1-37 amended by this Act, applies to the eligibility of a person who was killed in the line of duty before, on, or after the effective date 1-38 1-39 of this Act.

(b) The 1-40 Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall reconsider a nomination to have a person's name added to the Texas 1-41 Peace Officers' Memorial Monument under Section 3105.0035, Government Code, if the person was determined to be ineligible 1-42 1-43 before the effective date of this Act and the person may be eligible 1 - 441-45 under Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as amended by this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 1-46
