## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 552, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 552.916 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.916. CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AUTHORITY FOR
- 8 CERTAIN UTILITIES. (a) This section applies only to a board of
- 9 trustees described by Section 1502.070(a)(2)(B), Government Code.
- 10 (b) A board of trustees has the authority to establish a
- 11 bill payment assistance program for its utility system's customers
- 12 who have exhausted all private and nonprofit sources of utility
- 13 <u>assistance</u>. The program must be for customers:
- 14 (1) who received notice of disconnection of service
- 15 for nonpayment of bills; or
- 16 (2) who the utility determines are low-income
- 17 customers.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
