4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11 , Tax Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 11.211 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.211. REAL PROPERTY LEASED TO CERTAIN SCHOOLS. (a)
8	A person is entitled to an exemption from taxation of the portion of
9	the real property that the person owns and leases to an
10	open-enrollment charter school authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter
11	12, Education Code, that is qualified as provided by Section
12	<pre>11.21(d) of this code if:</pre>
13	(1) the real property is used exclusively by the
14	school for educational functions;
15	(2) the real property is reasonably necessary for the
16	operation of the school;
17	(3) the owner certifies by affidavit to the school
18	that the rent for the lease of the real property will be reduced by
19	an amount equal to the amount by which the taxes on the property are
20	reduced as a result of the exemption;
21	(4) the owner provides the school with a disclosure

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document stating the amount by which the taxes on the real property

are reduced as a result of the exemption and the method the owner

will implement to ensure that the rent charged for the lease of the

- 1 property fully reflects that reduction; and
- 2 (5) the rent charged for the lease of the real property
- 3 reflects the reduction in the amount of taxes on the property
- 4 resulting from the exemption through a monthly or annual credit
- 5 against the rent.
- 6 (b) Section 25.07 does not apply to a leasehold interest in
- 7 property for which the owner receives an exemption under this
- 8 section.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to ad valorem taxes imposed
- 10 for a tax year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020, but only
- 12 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 86th Legislature,
- 13 Regular Session, 2019, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 14 ad valorem taxation real property leased to certain schools
- 15 organized and operated primarily for the purpose of engaging in
- 16 educational functions is approved by the voters. If that amendment
- 17 is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
