Section 31.021(c), Education Code, as amended by Chapters 581 (S.B. 810) and 705 (H.B. 3526), Acts of the 85th 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended to 8 read as follows: 9 (c) in the state instructional 10 Money materials and 11 technology fund shall be used to: 12 (1) fund the instructional materials and technology 13 allotment, as provided by Section 31.0211; 14 (2) purchase special instructional materials for the education of blind and visually impaired students in public 15 16 schools; pay the expenses associated with the instructional 17 (3) materials adoption and review process under this chapter; 18 (4) pay the expenses associated with the purchase or 19 20 licensing of open education resource instructional material; 21 (5) pay the expenses associated with the purchase of 22 instructional material, including [intrastate] freight and 23 shipping and the insurance expenses associated with [intrastate] 24 freight and shipping;

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instructional materials, as provided by Subchapter B-1; 1 2 (H) instructional materials and technological equipment under any continuing contracts of the district in effect 3 on September 1, 2011; [and] 4 5 (I) technological equipment necessary to support 6 the use of materials included on the list adopted by the commissioner under Section 31.0231 or any instructional materials 7 8 purchased with an allotment under this section; and 9 (J) inventory software or systems for storing, managing, and accessing instructional materials and analyzing the 10 usage and effectiveness of the instructional materials; and 11 12 (2) pay: for training educational personnel directly 13 (A) 14 involved in student learning in the appropriate of use 15 instructional materials and for providing for access tο technological equipment for instructional use; and 16 17 (B) the salary and other expenses of an employee who provides technical support for the use of technological 18 equipment directly involved in student learning. 19 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
