## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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<b>1</b>	AIN	ACT

- 2 relating to training requirements for a member of the board of
- 3 trustees and the superintendent of an independent school district
- 4 regarding sexual abuse, human trafficking, and other maltreatment
- 5 of children.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 11.159, Education Code, is amended by
- 8 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (c-1), (c-2), and
- 9 (e) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) The State Board of Education shall require a trustee to
- 11 complete every two years at least:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> three hours of training [every two years] on
- 13 evaluating student academic performance; and
- 14 (2) one hour of training on identifying and reporting
- 15 potential victims of sexual abuse, human trafficking, and other
- 16 maltreatment of children.
- 17 (c-1) The training required by Subsection (c)(1) must be
- 18 research-based and designed to support the oversight role of the
- 19 board of trustees under Section 11.1515.
- 20  $\underline{(c-2)}$  A candidate for trustee may complete the training
- 21 required by Subsection (c) up to one year before the candidate is
- 22 elected. A new trustee shall complete the training within 120 days
- 23 after the date of the trustee's election or appointment. A
- 24 returning trustee shall complete the training by the second

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- 1 anniversary of the completion of the trustee's previous training.
- 2 (e) For purposes of this section, "other maltreatment" has
- 3 the meaning assigned by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 6 (h) Continuing education requirements for a superintendent
- 7 must include at least 2-1/2 hours of training every five years on
- 8 identifying and reporting potential victims of sexual abuse, human
- 9 trafficking, and other maltreatment of children. For purposes of
- 10 this subsection, "other maltreatment" has the meaning assigned by
- 11 Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- 12 SECTION 3. A superintendent subject to continuing education
- 13 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements
- 15 described by Section 21.054(h), Education Code, as added by this
- 16 Act, for any continuing education requirements period that ends
- 17 before January 1, 2021.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
