A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the civil liability of an educator justified in using

- 3 force in certain circumstances, suspension of a student who
- 4 assaults an employee of a school, and protection of an educator's

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 2, Education Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Chapter 38A to read as follows:
- 9 CHAPTER 38A. TEACHER'S PROTECTION ACT
- Sec. 38A.001. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as the
- 11 Teacher's Protection Act.
- 12 Sec. 38A.002. CIVIL IMMUNITY. An educator who uses force
- 13 that is justified in the manner provided by Chapter 9, Penal Code,
- 14 is entitled to civil immunity under Section 83.001, Civil Practice
- 15 and Remedies Code, for injury or death that results from the
- 16 educator's use of force or deadly force, as applicable.
- Sec. 38A.003. SUSPENSION. A principal or other appropriate
- 18 <u>administrator may suspend a student under Section 37.005 who</u>
- 19 engages in conduct that contains the elements of the offense of
- 20 <u>assault under Section 22.01</u>, Penal Code, against an employee of the
- 21 school, regardless of whether that conduct is identified in the
- 22 student code of conduct as conduct for which a student may be
- 23 suspended.
- Sec. 38A.004. EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION. An educator who uses

- 1 force that is justified in the manner provided by Chapter 9, Penal
- 2 Code, may not be suspended or terminated from employment or subject
- 3 to other disciplinary action solely as a result of the educator's
- 4 justified use of force.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
