Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 Art. 12.01. FELONIES. 4 the investigation of the offense shows that the person, other than 5 the legal spouse of the defendant, whom the defendant marries or 6 purports to marry or with whom the defendant lives under the 7 appearance of being married is younger than 18 years of age at the 8 time the offense is committed; or

9 (7) three years from the date of the commission of the 10 offense: all other felonies.

SECTION 2. Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended by this Act, does not apply to an offense if the prosecution of that offense becomes barred by limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
