A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to exceptions from the requirement for a person under the direction or control of a local entity or campus police department 3 to assist or cooperate with federal immigration officers. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 752.053(c), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(3), a local entity or 8 9 campus police department may prohibit persons who are employed by or otherwise under the direction or control of the entity or 10 11 department from assisting or cooperating with a federal immigration 12 officer if the assistance or cooperation occurs: 13 (1) at a place of worship; 14 (2) on the property of a school district, open-enrollment charter school, or private school; 15 16 (3) at an institution of higher education; or (4) at a hospital, emergency clinic, outpatient 17 clinic, birthing center, ambulatory surgical center, or other 18 facility providing health care services. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 24
