- 19 Sec. 54.103. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The Commissioners

- 4 (d) A master may administer oaths.
- 5 Sec. 54.104. JUDICIAL IMMUNITY. A master has the same
- 6 judicial immunity as a district judge.
- 7 Sec. 54.105. TRAINING. A master appointed under this
- 8 subchapter must successfully complete all training a justice of the
- 9 peace is required to complete under state law.
- Sec. 54.106. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SUMMONS OR ORDER. If an
- 11 attorney, party, witness, or any other person fails to comply with a
- 12 summons or order, the master may certify that failure in writing to
- 13 the referring court for appropriate action.
- Sec. 54.107. WITNESSES. (a) A witness appearing before a
- 15 master is subject to the penalties of perjury as provided by Chapter
- 16 37, Penal Code.
- 17 (b) A witness referred to the court under Section 54.106 is
- 18 subject to the same penalties and orders that may be imposed on a
- 19 witness appearing in a hearing before the court.
