- 2 relating to the extent of a defendant's criminal responsibility for
- 3 the conduct of a coconspirator in a capital murder case.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7.02(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) If, in the attempt to carry out a conspiracy to commit
- 8 one felony, another felony is committed by one of the conspirators,
- 9 all conspirators are guilty of the felony actually committed,
- 10 though having no intent to commit it, provided that [if] the offense
- 11 was committed in furtherance of the unlawful purpose and was one
- 12 that should have been anticipated as a result of the carrying out of
- 13 the conspiracy. This subsection does not apply to the prosecution
- 14 of the offense of capital murder.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to the prosecution of an offense committed on or after the effective
- 17 date of this Act. The prosecution of an offense committed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense
- 21 was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element
- 22 of the offense occurred before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
