Section 51.882, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read as 8 9 follows: Each institution of higher education that adopts a 10 (d) policy under Subsection (a): 11 12 (1) must require that the institution's campuses have personnel or volunteers authorized and trained to administer an 13 epinephrine auto-injector present; and 14 (2) shall include the policy in the institution's 15 16 student handbook or similar publication and publish the policy on the institution's Internet website. 17 18 (f) An institution of higher education that adopts a policy under Subsection (a) shall submit to the Department of State Health 19 Services a copy of the policy and any amendment to the policy 20 adopted by the institution. The department shall maintain a record 21 of the most recent policy and amendments submitted by each 22 23 institution under this subsection and shall make that information available to the public on request. 24
