A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a limitation on the authority to arrest a person for
- 3 certain misdemeanors punishable by fine only.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.1309 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.1309. CITE AND RELEASE POLICY. (a) In this article,
- 8 "law enforcement agency" means an agency of the state or an agency
- 9 of a political subdivision of the state authorized by law to employ
- 10 peace officers.
- 11 (b) Each law enforcement agency shall adopt a written policy
- 12 regarding the issuance of citations for misdemeanor offenses,
- 13 including traffic offenses, that are punishable by fine only. The
- 14 policy must provide a procedure for a peace officer employed by the
- 15 agency to verify a person's identity and issue a citation to a
- 16 person who fails to present proof of identification.
- 17 SECTION 2. Article 14.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 18 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) or (b), a peace officer
- 20 or any other person may not, without a warrant, arrest an offender
- 21 for a misdemeanor punishable by fine only, other than an offense
- 22 under Section 22.01(a)(2) or (3), Penal Code, or Section 49.02,
- 23 Penal Code.
- SECTION 3. Article 14.03, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

- 1 amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 2 (h) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), (d), or (g), a peace
- 3 officer may not, without a warrant, arrest a person who only commits
- 4 one or more offenses punishable by fine only, other than an offense
- 5 under Section 22.01(a)(2) or (3), Penal Code, or Section 49.02,
- 6 Penal Code.
- 7 SECTION 4. Article 14.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 8 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (b) A peace officer who is charging a person, including a
- 11 child, with committing an offense that is a [Class C] misdemeanor
- 12 punishable by fine only, other than an offense under Section 49.02,
- 13 Penal Code, shall [may], instead of taking the person before a
- 14 magistrate, issue a citation to the person that contains:
- 15 (1) written notice of the time and place the person
- 16 must appear before a magistrate;
- 17 (2) the name and address of the person charged;
- 18 (3) the offense charged;
- 19 (4) information regarding the alternatives to the full
- 20 payment of any fine or costs assessed against the person, if the
- 21 person is convicted of the offense and is unable to pay that amount;
- 22 and
- 23 (5) the following admonishment, in boldfaced or
- 24 underlined type or in capital letters:
- 25 "If you are convicted of a misdemeanor offense involving
- 26 violence where you are or were a spouse, intimate partner, parent,
- 27 or guardian of the victim or are or were involved in another,

- 1 similar relationship with the victim, it may be unlawful for you to
- 2 possess or purchase a firearm, including a handgun or long gun, or
- 3 ammunition, pursuant to federal law under 18 U.S.C. Section
- 4 922(g)(9) or Section 46.04(b), Texas Penal Code. If you have any
- 5 questions whether these laws make it illegal for you to possess or
- 6 purchase a firearm, you should consult an attorney."
- 7 (b-1) A peace officer who is charging a person, including a
- 8 child, with committing an offense that is a misdemeanor under
- 9 Section 22.01(a)(2) or (3), Penal Code, punishable by fine only
- 10 may, instead of taking the person before a magistrate, issue a
- 11 citation to the person that contains all of the information
- 12 required for a citation issued under Subsection (b).
- SECTION 5. Section 543.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 543.001. ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT AUTHORIZED. Any peace
- 16 officer may arrest without warrant a person found committing a
- 17 violation of this subtitle, other than a person found only
- 18 committing one or more misdemeanors punishable by fine only.
- 19 SECTION 6. Section 543.004(a), Transportation Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) An officer shall issue a written notice to appear if:
- 22 (1) the offense charged is <u>a misdemeanor under this</u>
- 23 <u>subtitle that is punishable by fine only</u>[+
- 24 [(A) speeding;
- 25 [(B) the use of a wireless communication device
- 26 under Section 545.4251; or
- [(C) a violation of the open container law,

1 Section 49.031, Penal Code]; and

- 2 (2) the person makes a written promise to appear in 3 court as provided by Section 543.005.
- 4 SECTION 7. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 6 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 7 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 8 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 9 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 10 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 11 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
