8	section [only if funds are available for that purpose] as follows:
9	(1) reimbursement for a school district not required
10	to take action under Chapter 41 may be provided from <u>any funds</u>
11	available to the commissioner for that purpose, as determined under
12	rules adopted under this section[+
13	[(A) amounts appropriated for that purpose ,
14	including amounts appropriated for those districts for that purpose
15	to the disaster contingency fund established under Section 418.073,
16	Government Code; or
17	[(B) Foundation School Program funds available
18	for that purpose, based on a determination by the commissioner that
19	the amount appropriated for the Foundation School Program,
20	including the facilities component as provided by Chapter 46,
21	exceeds the amount to which districts are entitled under this
22	chapter and Chapter 46]; and
23	(2) reimbursement for a school district required to
24	take action under Chapter 41 may be provided from funds described by

No. 500 Subdivision (1) [(1)(B)] if funds remain available after fully 1 reimbursing each school district described by Subdivision (1) for 2 its disaster remediation costs. 3 4 (h) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to implement this section, including rules: 5 6 (1) defining "disaster remediation costs" for purposes of this section; 7 8 (2) identifying funds available to the commissioner to provide reimbursement of disaster remediation costs under this 9 10 section; and 11 (3) specifying the type of documentation required under Subsection (e). 12 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
