1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety  
 1-22 standards in certain counties.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(c), Transportation Code, is  
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (c) A sheriff or a deputy sheriff of any of the following  
 1-27 counties [a county bordering the United Mexican States or of a  
 1-28 county with a population of 700,000 or more] is eligible to apply  
 1-29 for certification under this section:

- 1-30 (1) a county bordering the United Mexican States;
- 1-31 (2) a county with a population of 700,000 or more; or
- 1-32 (3) a county with a population of 400,000 or more that  
 1-33 borders the county in which the State Capitol is located.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 644.102, Transportation Code, is amended  
 1-35 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

1-36 (h) The department may revoke or rescind the authority of a  
 1-37 municipality or county to engage in enforcement under this chapter  
 1-38 if the municipality or county fails to comply with this section or  
 1-39 any standard established under Subsection (a).

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
