4	SECTION 1. Section 419.909, Government Code, is amended to

6	Sec. 419.909. FIRE SAFETY INSPECTIONS. (a) [Only and
7	individual certified by the commission as a fire inspector may

9	law, rule, regulation, or ordinance, may only be conducted by an
10	individual trained in accordance with the Standard for Professional
11	Qualifications for Fire Inspector and Plan Examiner as established
12	by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and certified
13	by:
14	(1) the Texas Commission on Fire Protection,
15	(2) the State Firemen's and Fire Marshals'
16	Association,
17	(3) the National Fire Protection Association,
18	(4) the International Code Council, or
19	(5) any other state agency with authority over fire
20	safety inspections.
21	(b) A fire safety inspection required by a state or local
22	law, rule, regulation, or ordinance must be conducted in accordance
23	with:
24	(1) the most recent local fire code; or

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- 1 (2) the most recent fire code adopted by the state fire
- 2 marshal.
- 3 (c) This section does not apply to state agency personnel
- 4 who conduct a life safety code survey of a building or facility in
- 5 connection with determining whether to issue or renew a license
- 6 under Chapter 142, 241, 242, 243, 244, 245, 247, 248, 251, 252, 464,
- 7 466, 577, Health and Safety Code, or Chapter 103, Human Resources
- 8 Code.
- 9 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 10 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 11 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 12 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 13 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
