9	Sec. 20.0631. TRANSACTION RECEIPT. The Department of
10	Public Safety shall issue a transaction receipt to each qualifying
11	applicant for a driver's license or personal identification
12	certificate who completes a voter registration application as
13	provided by Section 20.063. The receipt must include:
14	(1) the applicant's name;
15	(2) the date of issuance of the receipt;
16	(3) a statement indicating that the applicant
17	submitted a voter registration application; and
18	(4) the following statement: "This receipt is proof of
19	your application for voter registration. Retain it until you
20	receive a voter registration certificate from your local voter

- SECTION 3. Section 65.054, Election Code, is amended by

- (e) For purposes of Subsection (b)(1), a voter registration
- 16 receipt indicating the voter registered in the precinct in which
- 17 the voter voted that is attached to the envelope containing a
- 18 provisional ballot or presented to the voter registrar under
- 19 Section 63.011(f) is proof that a person who voted a provisional
- 20 ballot solely because the person's name was not on the list of
- 21 registered voters for the precinct in which the person voted is
- 22 eligible to vote in the election. The voter registrar shall amend
- 23 the list of registered voters accordingly.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
