1-20 relating to notice regarding summer weekend possession of a child
 1-21 under a standard possession order in a suit affecting the
 1-22 parent-child relationship.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 153.312, Family Code, is amended by
 1-25 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-26 (c) Notwithstanding Section 153.316, after receiving notice
 1-27 from the managing conservator under Subsection (b)(3) of this
 1-28 section designating the summer weekend during which the managing
 1-29 conservator is to have possession of the child, the possessory
 1-30 conservator, not later than the 15th day before the Friday that
 1-31 begins that designated weekend, must give the managing conservator
 1-32 written notice of the location at which the managing conservator is
 1-33 to pick up and return the child.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 153.312(c), Family Code, as added by
 1-35 this Act, applies only to a court order providing for possession of
 1-36 or access to a child rendered on or after the effective date of this
 1-37 Act. A court order rendered before the effective date of this Act
 1-38 is governed by the law in effect on the date the order was rendered,
 1-39 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
