A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of certain language regarding a person who is  
3 deaf or hard of hearing in statutes or resolutions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 392.002, Government Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

7 (b-1) In addition to the terms and phrases listed in  
8 Subsection (a), the legislature and the Texas Legislative Council  
9 are directed to avoid using in any new statute or resolution  
10 "hearing impaired," "auditory impairment," and "speech impaired"  
11 in reference to a deaf or hard of hearing person, and the  
12 legislature and the Texas Legislative Council are directed to  
13 replace, when enacting or revising a statute or resolution, those  
14 phrases with "deaf" or "hard of hearing," as appropriate.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
