- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 392.002, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) In addition to the terms and phrases listed in
- 8 Subsection (a), the legislature and the Texas Legislative Council
- 9 are directed to avoid using in any new statute or resolution
- 10 "hearing impaired," "auditory impairment," and "speech impaired"
- 11 in reference to a deaf or hard of hearing person, and the
- 12 <u>legislature</u> and the Texas Legislative Council are directed to
- 13 replace, when enacting or revising a statute or resolution, those
- 14 phrases with "deaf" or "hard of hearing," as appropriate.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
