SUBMISSION OF CERTAIN COMPLAINTS ΤO (a) The board shall submit to each 7 LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES. standing committee of the legislature having primary jurisdiction 8 9 over the board a copy of any complaint submitted to the board by a license holder regarding the board or an employee of the board, 10 including a complaint regarding the manner in which the board has 11 conducted an investigation of the license holder. 12

(b) The board shall submit the complaint and any related
information provided to the board not later than the 30th day after
the date the board receives the complaint or information.

16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to a complaint filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A 18 complaint filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by 19 the law in effect on the date the complaint was filed, and the 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
