- 18 SECTION 3. This Act applies to an employment contract that
- 19 is entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act. An employment contract that is entered into or renewed before
- 21 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 22 at the time the contract was entered into or renewed, and the former
- 23 law remains in effect for that purpose.

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
