## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the operation and inspection of mopeds; increasing a
  3 fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 521.085(a) and (b), Transportation 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) <u>Except</u> [<del>Unless prohibited by Chapter 522, and except</del>] as
- 8 provided by Subsection (b), Section 521.225, and Chapter 522, the
- 9 license holder may operate any vehicle of the type for which that
- 10 class of license is issued and any lesser type of vehicle other than
- 11 a motorcycle [or moped].
- 12 (b) Subsection (a) does not prohibit a license holder from
- 13 operating a lesser type of vehicle that is:
- 14 (1) a motorcycle described by Section 521.001(a)(6-a)
- or an autocycle as defined by Section 501.008; [or]
- 16 (2) a type of motorcycle defined by the department
- 17 under Section 521.001(c) and designated by the department as
- 18 qualifying for operation under this section; or
- (3) a moped.
- SECTION 2. Section 521.122(b), Transportation Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (b) The department may include on the driver's license:
- 23 (1) an authorization to operate a motorcycle [or
- 24 moped] if the license holder has met all requirements for a Class M

- 1 license; or
- 2 (2) an authorization for a person younger than 18
- 3 years of age to operate a moped as provided by Section 521.225.
- 4 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 521.225, Transportation
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 521.225. MOPED <u>AUTHORIZATION FOR PERSON YOUNGER THAN</u>
- 7 <u>18 YEARS OF AGE</u> [<del>LICENSE</del>].
- 8 SECTION 4. Sections 521.225(a) and (b), Transportation
- 9 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person 15 years of age or older but under 18 years of
- 11 <u>age</u> may [not] operate a moped <u>only if</u> [unless] the person holds:
- 12 <u>(1) a Class M license; or</u>
- 13 (2) another class of  $\left[\frac{1}{4}\right]$  driver's license with an
- 14 authorization to operate a moped. [An applicant for a moped license
- 15 must be 15 years of age or older.
- 16 (b) The department may issue an authorization to operate a
- 17 moped to a person who:
- 18 (1) is 15 years of age or older but under 18 years of
- 19 age; and
- 20 (2) passes [The department shall administer to an
- 21 applicant for a moped license] a written examination relating
- 22 specifically to the traffic laws applicable to the operation of
- 23 mopeds. [A test involving the operation of the vehicle is not
- 24 <del>required.</del>]
- 25 SECTION 5. Section 522.029(f), Transportation Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (f) If a commercial driver's license includes an

- 1 authorization to operate a motorcycle [or moped], the fee for the
- 2 driver's license is increased by \$8.
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 522.041(e), Transportation Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (e) The holder of a commercial driver's license or
- 6 commercial learner's permit may drive any vehicle in the class for
- 7 which the license or permit is issued and lesser classes of vehicles
- 8 except a motorcycle [or moped]. The holder may drive a motorcycle
- 9 only if authorization to drive a motorcycle is shown on the
- 10 commercial driver's license and the requirements for issuance of a
- 11 motorcycle license have been met. This subsection does not
- 12 prohibit a person from operating a lesser type of vehicle that is a
- 13 moped.
- SECTION 7. Section 548.051(b), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) A moped is subject to inspection in the same manner as a
- 17 motorcycle[, except that the only items of equipment required to be
- 18 inspected are the brakes, headlamps, rear lamps, and reflectors,
- 19 which must comply with the standards prescribed by Sections 547.408
- 20 and 547.801].
- 21 SECTION 8. Section 548.501(a), Transportation Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Except as provided by Sections 548.503 and 548.504, the
- 24 fee for inspection of a motor vehicle [other than a moped] is
- 25 \$12.50. [The fee for inspection of a moped is \$5.75.]
- SECTION 9. Section 521.225(c), Transportation Code, is
- 27 repealed.

- 1 SECTION 10. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Department
- 2 of Public Safety of the State of Texas shall:
- 3 (1) develop the written examination required by
- 4 Section 521.225(b), Transportation Code, as amended by this Act;
- 5 and
- 6 (2) adopt the rules necessary to implement Section
- 7 521.225, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
