- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 657.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 657.002. INDIVIDUALS QUALIFIED FOR VETERAN'S
- 8 EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE. The following individuals qualify for a
- 9 veteran's employment preference:
- 10 (1) a veteran, including a veteran with a disability;
- 11 (2) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not
- 12 remarried; [and]
- 13 (3) an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was killed
- 14 while on active duty; and
- 15 (4) the spouse of a veteran with a disability if the
- 16 veteran:
- 17 (A) has a total disability rating based either on
- 18 having a service-connected disability with a disability rating of
- 19 100 percent or on individual unemployability; and
- 20 (B) is receiving Supplemental Security Income
- 21 (SSI) benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq. or Social
- 22 <u>Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits under 42 U.S.C.</u>
- 23 Section 401 et seq.
- SECTION 2. Section 657.003(b), Government Code, is amended

- 1 to read as follows:
- 2 (b) A state agency shall provide to an individual entitled
- 3 to a veteran's employment preference for employment or appointment
- 4 over other applicants for the same position who do not have a
- 5 greater qualification a veteran's employment preference, in the
- 6 following order of priority:
- 7 (1) a veteran with a disability;
- 8 (2) a veteran;
- 9 (3) a spouse of a veteran with a disability as
- 10 described by Section 657.002(4);
- 11 (4) a veteran's surviving spouse who has not
- 12 remarried; and
- (5)  $[\frac{4}{1}]$  an orphan of a veteran if the veteran was
- 14 killed while on active duty.
- SECTION 3. Section 657.005(b), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (b) An applicant who is either a veteran with a disability
- 18 or a spouse of a veteran with a disability as described by Section
- 19 657.002(4) shall furnish the official records to the individual
- 20 whose duty is to fill the position.
- 21 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 an open position with a state agency for which the state agency
- 23 begins accepting applications on or after the effective date of
- 24 this Act. An open position with a state agency for which the state
- 25 agency begins accepting applications before the effective date of
- 26 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the state
- 27 agency began accepting applications, and the former law is

- 1 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
