- SECTION 1. Section 28.025(b-21), Education Code, is amended 5
- to read as follows:
- (b-21) In adopting rules under Subsection (b-1), the State 7
- Board of Education shall adopt criteria to allow a student to comply 8
- with the curriculum requirement for one credit under Subsection 9
- (b-1)(5) by successfully completing at an elementary school either 10
- 11 a dual language immersion program under Section 28.0051 or a course
- 12 in American Sign Language [at an elementary school].
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16
- Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 17
