1 actor was prohibited from living under the appearance of being 2 married under Section 25.01; or

3 (b) a person with whom the actor was 4 prohibited from engaging in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual 5 intercourse under Section 25.02.

6 (f) An offense under this section is a felony of the second
7 degree, except that an offense under this section is a felony of the
8 first degree if the victim was:

9 <u>(1)</u> a person whom the actor was prohibited from 10 marrying or purporting to marry or with whom the actor was 11 prohibited from living under the appearance of being married under 12 Section 25.01; or

13 (2) a person with whom the actor was prohibited from 14 engaging in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual intercourse under 15 Section 25.02.

16 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 17 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 18 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the 19 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 20 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 21 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
