- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 214.004, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 214.004. SEIZURE AND SALE OF PROPERTY TO RECOVER
- 8 EXPENSES. A Type A general-law municipality or home-rule
- 9 municipality may foreclose a lien on property under this
- 10 subchapter:
- 11 (1) in a proceeding relating to the property brought
- 12 under Subchapter E, Chapter 33, Tax Code; or
- 13 (2) in a judicial proceeding, if:
- 14 (A) a building or other structure on the property
- 15 has been demolished; and
- 16 (B) a lien for the cost of the demolition of the
- 17 building or other structure on the property has been created and
- 18 that cost has not been paid more than 180 days after the date the
- 19 lien was filed[; and
- 20 [(C) ad valorem taxes are delinquent on all or
- 21 part of the property].
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to the foreclosure of a lien that attaches under Subchapter A,
- 24 Chapter 214, Local Government Code, on or after the effective date

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- 1 of this Act. The foreclosure of a lien that attaches before the
- 2 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 3 date the lien attaches, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 4 purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
