- 15 (B) e-mail if the person has provided an e-mail

- 17 electronically;
- 18 (2) specify the date by which the surcharge must be

- 20 (3) state the total dollar amount of the surcharge
- 21 that must be paid, the total unpaid dollar amount of any previous
- 22 surcharge, the number of monthly payments required under an
- 23 installment payment plan, and the minimum monthly payment required
- 24 for a person to enter and maintain an installment payment plan with

- 1 the department; [and]
- 2 (4) state the consequences of a failure to pay the
- 3 surcharge; and
- 4 (5) provide information about the surcharge waiver
- 5 <u>available under Section 708.158 for persons who are indigent</u>.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
