The heading to Section 545.425, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 545.425. USE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE IN A SCHOOL CROSSING ZONE OR WHILE OPERATING A [SCHOOL] BUS WITH A MINOR 8 9 PASSENGER; LOCAL AUTHORITY [<del>POLITICAL SUBDIVISION</del>] STGN REQUIREMENTS; OFFENSE. 10 11 SECTION 2. Section 545.425, Transportation Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b-1), (b-2), (b-4), (c), and (d-1) and 12 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows: 13 14 (b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), a local authority [a municipality, county, or other political subdivision] 15 16 that enforces this section in a school crossing zone in the local authority's jurisdiction shall post a sign, or approve the posting 17 of a sign by a school or school district, that complies with the 18 standards described by this subsection at each [the] entrance to 19 20 the [each] school crossing zone [in the municipality, county, or 21 other political subdivision]. The Texas Department of Transportation [department] shall adopt standards that: 22 23 (1) allow for a sign required to be posted under this

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subsection to be attached to an existing sign at a minimal cost; and

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(2) require that a sign required to be posted under this subsection inform an operator that:

3 (A) the use of a wireless communication device is4 prohibited in the school crossing zone; and

5 (B) the operator is subject to a fine if the 6 operator uses a wireless communication device in the school 7 crossing zone.

(b-2) A local authority [municipality, county, or other 8 political subdivision] that by ordinance or rule prohibits the use 9 10 of a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle, including a prohibition that contains an exception for the use of a 11 wireless communication device with a hands-free device, throughout 12 the jurisdiction of the <u>local authority</u> [political subdivision] is 13 14 not required to post a sign as required by Subsection (b-1) and 15 shall:

16 (1) post signs that are located at each point at which 17 a state highway, U.S. highway, or interstate highway enters the 18 jurisdiction of the local authority [political subdivision] and 19 that state:

(A) that an operator is prohibited from using a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle in the jurisdiction of the local authority [political subdivision], and whether use of a wireless communication device with a hands-free device is allowed in the jurisdiction of the local <u>authority</u> [political subdivision]; and

(B) that the operator is subject to a fine if theoperator uses a wireless communication device while operating a

1 motor vehicle in the jurisdiction of the local authority [political
2 subdivision]; and

3 (2) subject to all applicable United States Department 4 of Transportation Federal Highway Administration rules, post a 5 message that complies with Subdivision (1) on any dynamic message 6 sign operated by the <u>local authority</u> [political subdivision] 7 located on a state highway, U.S. highway, or interstate highway in 8 the jurisdiction of the local authority [political subdivision].

9 (b-4) The <u>local authority</u> [political subdivision] shall pay 10 the costs associated with the posting of signs under <u>Subsections</u> 11 (b-1) and [Subsection] (b-2), unless the authority enters an 12 agreement providing otherwise.

13 (c) An operator may not use a wireless communication device 14 while operating a <u>school bus or</u> passenger bus with a minor passenger 15 on the bus unless the [<del>passenger</del>] bus is stopped.

16 (d-1) The affirmative defense available in Subsection 17 (d)(2) is not available for an offense under Subsection (b) 18 committed in a school crossing zone located in <u>the jurisdiction of a</u> 19 <u>local authority</u> [<u>a municipality</u>, <u>county</u>, <u>or other political</u> 20 <u>subdivision</u>] that is in compliance with Subsection (b-2).

21 (e-1) Subsection (c) does not apply to an operator of a
22 school bus or passenger bus using a wireless communication device:

- 23 (1) in the performance of the operator's duties as a
  24 <u>bus driver; and</u>
  25 (2) in a manner similar to using a two-way radio.
