## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the offense of operating certain vehicles without a
- 3 license plate.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.943(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A person commits an offense if the person operates on a
- 8 public highway during a registration period a road tractor,  $\underline{a}$
- 9 motorcycle, <u>a</u> trailer, <u>a</u> [<del>or</del>] semitrailer, <u>or a motor vehicle</u>
- 10 equipped with technology that would be impaired by the display of a
- 11 front license plate that does not display a license plate that:
- 12 (1) has been assigned by the department for the
- 13 period; and
- 14 (2) complies with department rules regarding the
- 15 placement of license plates.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 covered by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 23 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
