- 12 (c) In addition to the disclosure statement required by
- Section 255.001 or 255.008, as applicable, the first page of a slate 13
- mailer must indicate the full name and address of each person with 14
- final decision-making authority as to which candidates are 15
- 16 supported or opposed in the slate mailer.
- (d) A person may not knowingly cause to be published or 17
- distributed a slate mailer that does not include the disclosure 18
- 19 required by Subsection (c).
