- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 253, Election Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 253.006 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 253.006. UNLAWFUL USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR
- 9 CONTRIBUTIONS OR EXPENDITURES. (a) An officer or employee of a
- 10 political subdivision may not spend or authorize the spending of
- 11 public funds to make a political contribution or a political
- 12 <u>expenditure</u>.
- 13 (b) An officer or employee of a political subdivision may
- 14 not directly or indirectly employ a person to use public funds to
- 15 make an unlawful political contribution or political expenditure.
- 16 (c) A person who violates Subsection (a) or (b) commits an
- 17 offense. An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. Section 253.006, Election Code, as added by this
- 19 Act, applies only to a political contribution or a political
- 20 expenditure made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
